WELCOME TO THE CSF TRANSPORTATION BULLETIN –

You will find important information regarding school bus transportation for the students – your children.

Transportation registration will start on May 1st, 2021 until July 9th, 2021

Families registered before July 9th, 2021 should receive the details of their route stop and time during the two weeks prior to the beginning of the school year.

The CSF currently contracts for the operation of over 169 school bus routes providing school bus transportation service to CSF school students throughout B.C.

Changing student demographics requires a review of the bus routes each year, and to make adjustments where required. School bus routes are designed to service eligible students who have registered for the school bus before July 9th of the current school year and school bus routes will be prepared on the basis of registrations received before this date. Parents are reminded that they must register their children for the school bus EACH YEAR.

REMINDER

Parents may also use the on-line registration form to request a secondary stop at an alternate address to accommodate the parental custody and licensed day care needs of an eligible rider. A secondary stop must not alter or extend the existing route.

Please note Secondary Stops are strictly for:

- 1. parental custody
- 2. licensed daycares

The secondary stop is NOT for dance, music, art schools or any other activities in lieu of licensed child care.
