Thank you for the opportunity to provide you with the following proposal for consultation and the development of a conceptual landscape plan for École André Piolat. Our firm has been involved with many school projects including on multiphased seismic upgrades, new schools, and PAC-funded site improvements. We welcome the chance to work with the school community, CSF and stakeholders on this project.

### **CORPORATE PROFILE**

Prospect and Refuge Landscape Architects was incorporated in 2019 as a succession to Jonathan Losee Limited, which was incorporated in 1992. We provide personal and comprehensive Landscape Architectural services. Our firm consists of a principal, three senior staff, and 2-3 support staff. 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### PROJECT SCHEDULE, PHASES AND SCOPE

Anticipated project scope and associated team meetings are summarized by phase below, with a task-by-task breakdown of scope detailed in the associated table. Please note that the scope described is the maximum amount budgeted for in this proposal. If additional scope is required (meetings, site visits, deliverables, etc), it will be invoiced as an extra service on an hourly basis.

#### **SCHEDULE**

As discussed in our initial meeting, we can provide a conceptual master plan suitable for fundraising use by the end of June 2022.

#### **PHASES**

1: PROJECT START-UP: In this first phase of we will collect/review site information and assemble a site plan. We will complete a site visit and review background information provided by the PAC. If critical information is missing, we will notify the PAC so that they can source it. We will conduct a preliminary site review/analysis to understand the lay of the land, slopes and grading, existing pedestrian/vehicular circulation routes and views. We will also make photographic documentation of site. Please note that our fee does not include any arborist or survey services that may be required.

2: COMMUNITY AND STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATION: This phase will focus on filling in the gaps in the previous consultation process that were noted in our initial meeting. We will prepare a design consultation program for the school community and stakeholders, to share information about the consultation process and precedents, as well as gather information about priorities, opportunities, and constraints. This work would include planning/running a charrette with PAC involvement and communicating with the CSF as required. We plan to create a digital presentation for the community as an introduction to the consultation process and if possible, have PAC volunteers and teachers deliver the in-person charettes. We will analyze the results of the consultation and compile this into a summary report.

**CONCEPTUAL PLAN FOR FUNDRAISING:** Based on the results of the Consultation process, a draft concept plan will be prepared for initial submission showing hard and soft landscaping, plant massing, playground locations, etc. We will meet with the PAC for review and approval of the draft plan. Following sign-off on the draft design, a final conceptual plan will be prepared showing hard surfacing, existing trees, preliminary grades, new plant material with a plant list, site furniture and special features as required for review and sign-off by the PAC and CSF. The plan will include precedent imagery to illustrate design intent.

**FUTURE PHASES:** Following completion of the scope described above, we would be happy to provide design development, tender, contract documents and construction administration services. We can provide a fee and scope proposal for this work once the concept plan is complete. Fees for these future phases are not included in the current proposal.

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#### **SERVICES AND FEES**

Prospect and Refuge Landscape Architects proposes to provide Landscape Architectural services as described above according to the following schedule of fees. We recommend billing hourly for this work to an agreed upon upset amount of \$15,145 excluding GST, which represents the total hourly fees we estimate to complete the scope of work described in this proposal (\$1,430 for Phase 1, \$10,075 for Phase 2, and \$3,640 for Phase 3). This billing method will allow the PAC maximum flexibility to control expenses and budget.

Additional services that are requested beyond the scope of work described in this proposal will be in addition to the upset amount and billed hourly based upon our current schedule of hourly rates. At this date our hourly rates are as follows:

Principal Landscape Architect: A Semczyszyn \$160.00 Landscape Architect: L Davis \$130.00 Intern Landscape Architect: S Hunt-Weeks \$110.00

Reimbursable disbursements such as printing of drawings, specifications, courier, travel outside of Vancouver (nursery visits), etc. are in additional to the above and will be passed on at cost + 10% for handling.

GST will be additional to the above fees.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

The Landscape Architect shall not be responsible for structural design or architectural changes to the building shell. The Landscape Architect cannot be held responsible for the performance of manufacturers and suppliers. The Landscape Architect will act in good faith to specify products from dependable sources and will endeavour to use any possible leverage on such supplies to ensure their performance.

This Agreement shall be of benefit and binding upon the parties hereto and except as hereinafter otherwise provided, their administrators, permitted successors and assigns. Except as aforesaid, neither party may assign this Agreement without the consent in writing of the other. This Agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the Client and the Landscape Architect and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both the Client and the Landscape Architect. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of British Columbia.

For the purposes of the limitation of liability provisions contained in the Agreement of the parties herein, the Client expressly agrees that it has entered into this Agreement with the Consultant, both on its own behalf and as agent on behalf of its employees and principals. The Client expressly agrees that the Consultant's employees and principals shall have no personal liability to the Client in respect of a claim, whether in contract, tort, and/or any other cause of action in law.

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Accordingly, the Client expressly agrees that it will bring no proceedings and take no action in any court of law against any of the Consultant's employees or principals in their personal capacity.
